NSWCCC or NSWPCS (MacKillop or Polding) Team Coach



TENURE

October – October – 12 Months

APPOINTMENT

By self-nomination on the CSNSW Sport Portal. The application must be endorsed by the Diocesan Representative and the nominee's Principal.

ROLE

An opportunity for teachers in the Catholic school system to use their sport and coaching skills to support talented and emerging students in their chosen sport. In the role of Coach, you will play a crucial role in leading and developing the NSWCCC, Polding or MacKillop (NSWPCS) team in the lead-up to, during and post-participation in NSWPSA, NSW All Schools or other relevant state or national events. Through this role, you will work collaboratively in providing a pathway to State and National representation for students in NSW Catholic primary and secondary schools.

TIME COMMITMENT

The NSWCCC or NSWPCS Team Coach is required to liaise with the sport Convenor or CSNSW in creating selection documentation, liaise with other team officials on roles and expectations for the selections and the NSWPSA or NSW All Schools event; attend the NSWPCS or NSWCCC sport selections and lead the selection panel; attend the NSWPSA or NSW All Schools championship or other state-based competitions

ALLOWANCE

CSNSW Sport will fund teacher relief for days to attend NSWPCS or NSWCCC Selections and NSWPSA or NSW All Schools events, plus travel days where needed.

CSNSW Sport will also provide the Coach with a uniform allowance to purchase NSWPCS or NSWCCC merchandise.

Where the Coach is required to stay overnight, CSNSW Sport will also fund accommodation, breakfast, and dinner.

IN THE POSITION OF COACH, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- Workshop the NSWPCS or NSWCCC selections event with CSNSW Sport and the relevant Convenor
- Assist with the organisation of the format of NSWPCS or NSWCCC selections.
- Prepare (with CSNSW Sport or Convenor) a selection proforma identifying key skills and athlete elements.
- Assist in keeping the Operations Guidelines current and relevant.
- Be familiar with NSWPCS or NSWCCC and NSWPSA or NSW All Schools rules and selection guidelines

PRIOR TO NSWPCS or NSWCCC TEAM SELECTION EVENTS

- Liaise with other team officials and selectors – provide guidance on the selection process, expectations and an overview of skills being examined.
- Prepare and then guide the selection panel on selection documentation.

AT THE NSWPCS or NSWCCC TEAM SELECTION EVENT

- Provide an overview of the selection trial format and what selectors will be looking for.
- Induct selectors on the selection process and documents.
- Liaise with CSNSW Sport and sport Convenor
- Oversee selections

AFTER THE NSWCPSS or NSWCCC TEAM SELECTION EVENT

- Provide the sport Convenor or CSNSW Sport with the NSWCPSS or NSWCCC team lists and playing numbers upon completion of selections.
- Liaise with other Team Officials as to roles and in next steps of the pathway.
- Submit training proposal to CSNSW Sport office (if relevant)
- Deliver training session / camp in the lead up to the next event (if relevant)

AT THE NSWPPSSA or NSW ALL SCHOOLS EVENT

- Liaise with the team manager regarding the selected students and the information required.
- Prepare the team for the competition.
- Liaise with staff from other associations and assist with the NSWPPSSA or NSW All Schools team selections.
- Attend all event/management/selection meetings.
