		С	First Aid  i) Designated first aid officer must be in attendance and be visible. First aid officer should be equipped with ice and medical supplies including for the treatment of asthma and anaphylaxis  ii) Physiotherapy & taping services will not be provided at selections by the designated first aid officer.  iii) First aid officer to be informed of any students at high risk by Team Manager.  iv) Diocesan Team Managers should access the medical information on each student from the CSNSW website.  v) Players should ensure that they have an adequate level of hydration before, during, and after the game or training session.  Concussion  i) It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform team management of any concussion recently sustained.  ii) Any student who has sustained a recent concussion injury may not return to contact/collision activities until the resolution of all symptoms.  iii) specific guidelines from the National Sport Organisation in relation to returning to play after a concussion.  For further information refer to Sports Medicine Australia  iv) A medical clearance must be provided to your Diocesan Representative prior to the Polding selections

		d	Catchers are to wear helmets, face masks with throat protectors, body protectors and leggings.
		е	Students must wear shin guards which are compulsory.
		f	Footwear that conforms to the laws of the game must be worn.
		g	Students must remove jewellery and other ornaments likely to cause injury. Students must also cut or tape long fingernails.
