



# Golf Camp

Maitland Newcastle Catholic Schools has partnered with Golf NSW to provide an opportunity for students to participate in a two-day Golf camp during the upcoming holiday period. It will kickstart or further an individual's love of golf and will provide further opportunities in the sport.

This program aims to teach essential movement skills, the golf swing, and target alignment, while emphasising power generation, ball flight, and trajectory through interactive games. It also fosters qualities such as control, focus, concentration, and teamwork, offering participants the chance to utilise their skills on the golf course and explore additional opportunities in schools, Jack Newton Junior Golf, and local clubs.

This camp is based on ability and experience. Students are grouped accordingly ensuring like-abilities in groups

## Information

- This is a two day camp
  - Day 1 :
    - Sessions and skill set-up to reflect the student's skills.
    - Play some holes in the afternoon
  - Day 2 :
    - Play Golf
    - Scoring
    - Targets of achievement
- Students are to attend both days of the camp

## Dates

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July – Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2026

## Venue - Golf Club

Branxton Golf Club, Cessnock Road Branxton

## Timings

- Student registration 8:30am (Please do not arrive earlier than this as there will be no supervision)
- Camp begins 9.00 am
- Camp concludes at 3.00 pm

## Age criteria

- Students in years 5 to 8
- This camp is based on ability and experience.
- Students are grouped accordingly ensuring like-abilities in groups and not on a friendship basis

## Gender

- Boys and Girls

## Eligibility

- The Golf Camp is open to students enrolled in a Maitland Newcastle Diocesan school.

## Cost

- \$100

## Apparel

Students are required to wear School Sport uniform

## Equipment

- Students who have their own clubs are permitted to bring them at their own risk
- Students are not permitted to share their clubs with other participating students
- Students who do not have their own clubs will be provided with clubs

## What to bring

- Personal equipment should be marked clearly with the child's name and school.
- Students are to come prepared for all types of weather conditions.
- Items to bring include:
  - Deodorant and/or antiperspirant
  - Water bottle
  - Hat
  - Sunscreen
- The Diocese of Maitland Newcastle is not responsible for any items, electronic equipment, phones or valuable personal items that may go missing or get damaged while the student is travelling to the session, participating in the session and travelling from the session

## Camp Catering

- Students are to bring their own food and refreshments to the camp.
- This includes lunch, snacks and plenty of water, with a refillable water bottle.

## Medical

- Any relevant medical conditions such as Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Diabetes, Allergies needs to be detailed on the Catholic Schools NSW Sport portal.
- If any child has a medical condition, it is the responsibility of the accompanying adult to ensure that the appropriate medication (i.e. epipen, ventolin, etc) is brought to the camp.
- **Students who require medication but do not present it at registration will not be permitted to participate. Please ensure the medical information during the registration process is correct**

## Registration

- Spots are limited and are capped at the first 40 students being registered on the Catholic Schools NSW Sport portal
- Registration will be closed prior to the closing date if the total number of registrations has been reached
- Registration close on **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026**
- Refunds will only be provided in the case of a medical certificate
- Follow the below steps to register

## STEP 1: CREATE A PARENT ACCOUNT

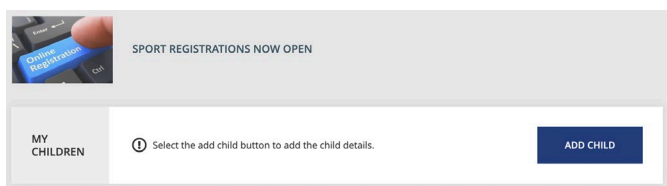
If you have previously registered your child in a sport and already have a CSNSW Sport account please proceed to Step 3

- Visit [www.csnsw.sport](http://www.csnsw.sport)
- Click on CREATE ACCOUNT in the top right corner
- Make sure you have selected to make a PARENT account
- Complete all mandatory fields and click CREATE ACCOUNT. You will receive a confirmation email.



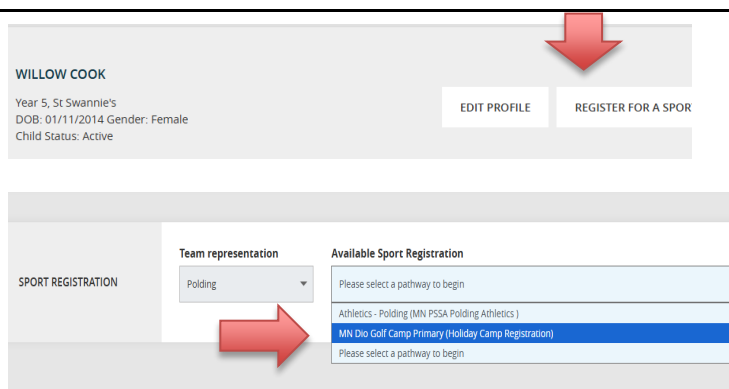
## STEP 2: ADDING YOUR CHILD

- Once you have been taken to your dashboard, click on ADD CHILD
- Complete all mandatory fields on all pages
- Once you have completed all fields, click ADD CHILD
- You will now see your child's profile summary



## STEP 3: REGISTER FOR A SPORT

- After locating your child's profile, click on REGISTER FOR A SPORT
- Select **'MN Dio Golf Camp (July Golf Holiday Camp)'** from the drop down menu. *Note Team representation will be Polding for Primary, CCC for Secondary*
- Click NEXT on 'Registration Details' section
- Review your child's details and if they are correct make sure you tick the "ACKNOWLEDGMENT" box and click NEXT
- Sport Specific Details – All information regarding the camp can be found here. Please read all event information, code of conduct and fill in the custom information required. Click **Next**
- Consent to participate Complete all the fields and click **Next**.



## STEP 4: ADD TO CART

- Ensure the Holiday Camp has been added to your shopping cart and that the total is displaying \$100
- Follow checkout steps - checkout > provide address details > go to payment > credit or debit card > enter credit card details > proceed with payment. Click FINISH
