1	GENERAL RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parents, coaches, and spectators are not permitted on the pool deck or in the marshalling areas at any time during the competition Swimmers must compete in their designated age group for the entire meet Swimmers are responsible for reporting punctually to the marshalling area when called Once competitors are in the hands of the officials, they may not receive advice or coaching Competitors must remain in the water until instructed to exit by the referee.
2	AGE DIVISIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ages are determined as of 31st December in the year of competition NSWCPS (Primary) Divisions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Junior: 8, 9, 10 years Senior: 11, 12, 13 years NSWCCC (Secondary) Divisions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Junior: 12 - 14 years Intermediate: 15 - 16 years Senior: 17+ years Please note, <u>the 12/13 age group is a combined age group for all 50m and 100m events</u>
3	RELAY EVENTS	<p>NSWCCC (Secondary)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Relay teams will earn points towards overall team standings <p>NSWCPS (Primary)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 4 x 50m Freestyle Relays: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Junior & Senior – Separate boys and girls races Small Schools (Earl Magee & Peter Dobson) – Mixed boys and girls Relay teams must be enrolled at the same school

4	SWIMWEAR REGULATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competitors must wear swimwear that meets Swimming Australia GR 19.1.5 No zippers or fastening devices (except for waist ties) Swimwear must be textile and not treated to close open mesh structures
5	COMPETITION RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One Start Rule applies (disqualified if starting before the signal) Electronic devices are prohibited in competition/marshalling areas Shirt must be worn during the medal presentation Manual times will be used if electronic timing fails
6	MULTI-CLASS EVENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All MC swimmers must provide proof of an eligible classification Winners are determined by the Multi-Class Points System (MCPS), comparing times to World Records
7	DISQUALIFICATIONS & PROTESTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NSWCCC & NSWCPs: Protests must be submitted to the Convenor in writing within 15 minutes of the posting of results
8	ELECTRONIC TIMING & RESULTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Times on scoreboards are unofficial until confirmed. Results are available: Meet Mobile App, Hy-Tek App or the NSWCCC/NSWCPS Swimming Championship site If the electronic touchpad is not activated, Olly timing will be utilised.
9	PHOTOGRAPHY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parents cannot enter the pool deck for medal photos.
10	FIRST AID & SAFETY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First Aid is available at Level One. Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre Integrated Management System will be activated in emergencies.

11 Further Representation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● NSWPSSA (Primary) Qualifiers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters, from each event including Multi-Class competitors (officially classified) will qualify for the MacKillop or Polding teams to compete at the NSWPSSA State Swimming Championships. ○ In the event of a tie for 3rd place, a swim off will take place. ● NSWCCC (Secondary) Qualifiers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters, from each event including Multi-Class competitors (officially classified) will qualify for the NSWCCC team to compete at the NSW All Schools State Swimming Championships. ○ In the event of a tie for 3rd place, a swim off will take place.
