- Injured/ill students can apply for Special Consideration if they provide a doctor's certificate that clearly indicates they can't participate on the day/s of the Diocesan Trial.
- The Diocesan Education Officer for Sport will be required to endorse this application. Successful applications will then be given to the Diocesan Convenor to consider **if there are any withdrawals**. For those who were in the Diocesan Team for this sport in the previous year, they can be **considered** for the **team** regardless of withdrawals.
- The School Sports Coordinator will be required to endorse the application.
- The parent/guardian of the students must sign this document as true and accurate information.
- A DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATE must be supplied with this application.
