

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

INJURY/ILLNESS FORM FOR DIO TRIALS – SWIMMING & ATHLETICS

This does not grant a student directly into the Diocesan Team. It allows them to be considered as a wildcard entry which is dependent on csnsw approval.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Injured/ill students can apply for Special Consideration if they provide a doctor's certificate that clearly indicates they can't participate on the day/s of the Diocesan Trial.
- The Diocesan Education Officer for Sport will be required to endorse this application. This involves comparing the students school carnival result with the Diocesan results and if their school result places them in the top 2 at Dio, then they will be sent to CSNSW **as a wildcard entry**. Wildcard entries are not guaranteed & students aren't notified until 1 week prior to the NSWCCC event.
- The School Sports Coordinator will be required to endorse this application.
- The parent/guardian of the students must sign this document as true and accurate information.
- A DOCTOR CERTIFICATE must be supplied with this application.
- This application must be emailed to both the Diocesan Education Officer & the **Convenor by 9.30am of the day of the Diocesan selection trial being held –** bernadette.duggan@mn.catholic.edu.au or melissa.lidbury@mn.catholic.edu.au. Convenor details are in your registration information pack.
